COD-012-Betzen	Bill Betzen	Map was withdrawn


- The Commissioners are encouraged to review all map plans that have been submitted for the week, as some submitters may decline to present.

- Max Dev – 3.66%
- # of Minority Districts – 7
- NH-Black – 1 (14)
- Hispanic – 6 (6,7,10,11,12,13)
- Districts 9, 11 and 14 have low compactness scores
- # of neighborhood associations split – 28 out of 443




(NH White – Yellow, Hispanic – Red; NH Black – Blue)

- Max Dev – 8.12%
- # of Minority Districts – 8
- (NH Black – 1, Hispanic - 7)
- NH Black – 8
- HISP – 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9
- # of neighborhood associations split – 25 out of 443
